This Indenture made this fifth day of January in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred fourteen between Arthur S. Hogan of the State of Tennessee County of Smith of the one part and John Denny of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Arthur S. Hogun for and in consideration of the sum of ninety dollars to him in hand paid by him the said John Denny before the sealing and delivering of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth fully freely and absolutely give grant bargain sell release and confirm unto him the said John Denny a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the county of Smith state of Tennessee upon the waters of Mulherrins Creek and \_\_\_\_\_ as follows to wit Beginning at a white oak and ash on a small branch near William Moores line, running North 90 poles to a sugar tree thence so 78 % w 30 poles to a sugar tree and hickory thence North 100 poles to a white oak and hackberry then west 54 poles to a hickory thence so 6 poles to an ash then west 177 poles to an ash and walnut then so 137 poles to an ash and sugar tree on the branch and then down the branch with its several meanders to the beginning containing one hundred and thirty seven acres of land, to have and to hold with all the profits privileges hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said John Denny his heirs and assigns forever, and the said Arthur S Hogan for the \_\_\_\_\_ of the said granted premises doth covenant and agree for himself his heirs exs. and admins to warrant and defend the said granted premises against the lawful claims of any person or persons whatsoever but to the only and proper use and behoof of him the said John Denny his heirs and assigns forever. 148 acres on Mulherrin Creek. 6 August 1814. (Deed Book F p. 401)

This Indenture made this sixth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fourteen between Arthur L. Hogan of the one part of the County of Smith and State of Tennessee and John Paschal of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Arthur L. Hogan for an in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said John Paschal the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given bargained sold allied conveyed and confirmed unto the sd John Paschal his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the county and State aforesaid on the Waters of Mulherins Creek butted and bounded as follows to wit beginning on a beach and Sugar tree Benjamin Denney's Northwest Corner running East one hundred and fifty poles to an ash thence North to Jonas corner continuing no to Almon's Corner thence west to Benjamin Denny's no east corner containing one hundred and forty eight acres of land to have and to hold the aforesaid land with all and singular the wrights profits and emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances of in and to the same belonging or in any wise pertaining to the only proper use and behoof of him the sd John Paskell his heirs and assigns forever and the sd Arthur L. Hogun of the one part and Taylor Whitley of the other part both of the County of Smith State of Tennessee witeseth that the said A.L. Hogan in consideration of the sum of Sixty six dollars to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold aligned in \_\_\_\_\_ and conveyed to the said Taylor Whitley a certain tract of land situate lying and being in the county and state aforesaid beginning at Jones Bishop south west corner at two lynn trees running south one hundred and forty four poles to Benjamin Denneys corner thence east [p. 406] with Denneys line and Paskels line one hundred and seventy two poles to Almons line thence north with said line one hundred and forty four poles to Bishops line thence to the Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty five acres of land be the same more or less to have and to hold the said granted premises to him the said Taylor Whitley his heirs and assigns forever to his only proper use and behoof and benefit free from the said A L Hogun his heirs executors administrators and assigns and all and every other person or persons whatsoever and the sd A. Hogan of the one part of the County of Smith and State of Tennessee and Samuel Paschal of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Arthur L. Hogan for and in Consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to him in hand Paid by the said Samuel Paschal the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained sold alied Conveyed and Confirmed unto the said Samuel Paschal his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the county and State aforesaid on the Waters of Mulherrins Creek butted and bounded as follows, to wit beginning on Hogans West boundary line at a beech Running East two hundred and sixty pole to a red oak and buckeye thence North Seventy three poles west to hundred and sixty pole to a Walnut thence south seventy three pole to the beginning containing one hundred and eighteen acres and one half to have and to hold the aforesaid land with all and singular the rights profits emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances of in and to the same belonging in any wise appertaining to the only proper use and behoof of him the sd Samuel Paschal his heirs and assigns forever and the said Aurthur L.
